## AGM - 9th October 2022- PRESIDENT'S SPEECH

### WELCOME

The last couple of years will certainly be tagged as one of the most turbulent times in the history of mankind caused by the Covid 19 pandemic. It had shaken everyone, and we were not the exception.

Whilst our building work was in progress, suddenly the government declared lockdown as a result of which the income of the temple drastically dropped, labour shortages, construction materials became scarce, and costs started climbing.

**Survival**: With the help of our congregation and with the **concerted efforts** by the committee and our head priest, we managed to come out well, but it was not easy.

## **GRATITUDE AND THANKS**

On behalf of the entire Committee, we pay **gratitude** to those who helped us during this difficult time and made a **significant difference** for the wellbeing of SGB.

We would not be able to name everyone due to the time constraints but would like to say thank you at least to those who are present here at this meeting today. As stated at the last AGM, the committee will arrange a thanksgiving function to honour those who helped the SGB's building project.

Acharya Dharm Dutt ji: Our sincere thanks go to Dharm Dutt ji who is the pillar of this temple and a big asset. He has raised over £100,000 by arranging the Shatchandi Maha Yagya and Pran Pratishtha of Lord Hanuman, Chitragupt Bhagwan, Shani Dev and idols of Nav Graha, and I would also like to remind you that he raised the sum of £85,000 at the last Yagya ceremony. The Yagya not only had divine significance, but it was also like the entire community coming together in a very spiritually charged atmosphere.

Apart from doing his own work, he works as a caretaker, receptionist, telephonist, taking bookings, managing several festivals, and many other tasks which a full-time manager is supposed to do. He also holds free classes such as:

His duties are vast and many, among them supervising the accounting of money and banking it, keeping all accounting records up to date, arranging wage slips, payment to staff and others, providing a monthly financial report to the committee, delivering records to the accountant, arranging accounts, and many other tasks. With his honesty & integrity we are moving forward.

**Dr Arun Sinha Ji** played a great supporting role helping me to do my tasks, representing the SGB to various meetings and functions in the city. He is my right hand.

**Mr. Kashav Sehra** has been instrumental in getting home office grants, alarm system, sound system, debit card donation machine, helping me to develop a risk management strategy alongside Dr Sinha Ji dealing with covid 19, and managing all communications on social media and virtual poojas during the pandemic. He made an Application for a Govt grant for improving Security with new CCTV cameras and fences, which was successful as we received £56K from the home office and we contributed £16k, the outcome of which is that we now have high-definition CCTV with proper alarm system. After installation, attempts made by intruders twice were unsuccessful and the culprits were arrested.

We witnessed his singing Garba songs during Navratri for a continuous period of 10 days. He has been carrying out all the duties which the late RK Duggal ji was carrying out.

**Mr. Raj Dutta Ji** dedicates all his spare hours for various work for the temple especially in respect of any maintenance required and kitchen duties. During any break ins at the temple, or if the intruder alarm goes off, he comes to the temple even if it is in the middle of the night without fail to attend to the situation. Pandit ji spoke, and I translated the talk, which was very well received by the audience. **Mr. Shiv Passi ji** assisted the treasurer with accounting and banking, and with disposing of surplus stock to collect money for the SGB.


